## **Special Notes**

Dogs must be on a leash at all times.

All riders are asked to check in with the show office to sign the Fairground's release form.

If renting a stall, you need to bring your own shavings/bedding. All horses must be in rented stalls overnight (no portables or tying). We will attempt to stall all persons who wish to be outdoors but, if necessary, will provide outdoor stalls on a first-come/first-served basis. More ground has been added to the indoor stall barn and warm-up arena—no need to worry about concrete floors anymore!

To help keep costs down, please muck out your stall into the alleyway prior to departure.

Daily haul-in's are asked to rake up all horse manure into piles next to where they are parked.

All camping sites have water and power; a limited number of RV spots are available with sewage service on a first-come/first-served basis. The camping fee is required of all who camp overnight, regardless if hook-up's are used or not.

Open average bonus money will be based on horse/rider combinations for all three Open races.

The processing fee is per horse for the entire weekend; the late fee is per rider for the entire weekend.

There is no dress code at any of the races.

A horse can be entered in a race only once; no sharing.
