Limit 25 head

\$1,500 Entry Fee / 100% Payback

Slot race is open to horses four (4) and (5) year olds (foals of 2006 or after) who have never competed for money, points or prizes in barrel racing prior to December 1, 2010.

- Limit 1 slot per owner/1 horse per rider
- Rider must be current 2011 WPRA Member in good standing
- Horses and riders to be named at, or prior to, event check in
- All slot horses must also be entered in the WPRA Pro Futurity
- Slot horses will be identified and numbered on Thursday, October 13 from 2pm - 4pm in the Pavilion I holding pen

Slot buyers may pay in full or use the above payment program. Buyers opting to pay in full must do so on or before July 15, 2011. Should a buyer opt to make payments **ABSOLUTELY NO LATE PAYMENTS WILL BE ALLOWED**. Once a buyer has paid in full for a slot, that buyer will have first right of refusal on re-purchase of the slot each subsequent year. Should a slot buyer fail to make a sustaining payment within 10 days of the postmark deadline, all prior fees paid will be forfeited and the defaulted slot may be sold by WPRA to a new buyer. All partial payments on defaulted slots will be included in slot purse. By making a payment toward the purchase of a slot for the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot Race, buyers agree to abide by all the WPRA rules and associated ground rules for World Finals competition, Pro Futurity and WPRA World Finals Pro Futurity Slot Race.

WPRA WORLD FINALS PRO FUTURITY SLOT RACE - GROUND RULES

Saturday, October 15, 2011 • Night Performance

1. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race is open to horses **5 YEARS OLD & UNDER IN 2011 (FOALS OF 2006 OR AFTER)** that have never competed in barrel racing for money, points or prizes, prior to December 1, 2010.
2. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race Entry Fee is \$1,500. It is payable all at once on or before July 20, 2011, or in three (3) payments of \$500 with post mark due dates as follows: Payment 1 \$500, postmark due date on July 15, 2011 / Payment 2 \$500, postmark due date on August 15, 2011 / Payment 3 \$500, postmark due date on September 15, 2011.
3. Should a buyer opt to make payments: **ABSOLUTELY NO LATE PAYMENTS WILL BE ALLOWED.** Should a slot buyer fail to make a sustaining payment within 10 days of the postmark deadline, all prior fees paid will be forfeited and the defaulted slot may be sold by WPRA to a new buyer.
4. All partial payments on defaulted slots will be included in slot purse. By making a payment toward the purchase of a slot for the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race, buyers agree to abide by all the rules applying to the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race and WPRA World Finals Pro Futurity.
5. Once a buyer has paid in full for a slot, that buyer will have first right of refusal on re-purchase of the slot each subsequent year that there is a race.
6. **NO REFUNDS — NO EXCEPTIONS**
7. **Horses entered in the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race must also be entered in the WPRA World Finals Pro Futurity.**
8. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race format will be one run with straight payoff.
9. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race competition will be run separately from the WPRA World Finals Pro Futurity.
10. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race is limited to 25 horses, 1 horse per rider, and 1 slot per owner.
11. Horses and riders must be named at check in (horses not already entry.)
12. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race & WPRA World Finals Pro Futurity horses will be identified and numbered on Thursday, October 13 from 2pm - 4pm in the Pavilion I holding pen.
13. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race competition will be run separate from the WPRA World Finals Pro Futurity with the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race being held during the Saturday, October 15th, evening performance.
14. WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race purse will consist of 100% payback from entry fees. **If race fills the purse will consist of \$37,500 with paid places as follows: 1st \$15,000 / 2nd \$10,000 / 3rd \$6,000 / 4th \$4,000 / 5th \$2,500**

GENERAL RULES: MEMBERS MUST REFER TO THE WPRA RULE BOOK

Dress Code: Long-sleeved shirt, long pants, western hat, and western boots. Per WPRA rule book.

Next Five On Deck in the Holding Pen: Contestant shall identify themselves to the Arena Director and be in the holding area as instructed by Arena Director prior to making their run. The Arena Director will be located next to the entryway into the holding pen.

Failure to do so will result in a disqualification. The announcer will call contestant's name three times within 60 seconds, if the contestant is not in the holding pen by the third call they will be disqualified. Only one horse may be in the alleyway at any time.

Tie for Purse & Prizes: If any contestant's times are tied, the prize money will be split equally and a roll of the dice between the tied contestants will determine the tie for the awards. High roll wins.

Payout Requirements: Checks will be issued to the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot owner. In order to receive your money, each owner must have a W-9 form on file in the event office. Likewise any prizes awarded in the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race will be awarded to the slot owner.

Disqualifications: In addition to anything specifically listed in these Ground Rules, refer to the WPRA rule book.

WPRA Membership Required: Riders of horses entered in the WPRA Pro Futurity Slot race must be current 2011 WPRA members in good standing.

The WPRA rule book will be followed. A rule book will be mailed with your entry confirmation.

Safety: Safety is a prime objective at this barrel race. If you have a horse that could be dangerous to yourself, other contestants, or other horses, DO NOT bring it to this barrel race. Any horse or contestant deemed to be dangerous by the management of WPRA will be disqualified and entry fees will not be refunded.

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
