

2012 WRANGLER CANADIAN RODEO TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP

GROUND RULES

1. Top thirty two (32) from each of the six major events that enter, plus the top thirty two (32) team roping headers and the top thirty two (32) team roping heelers that enter from the 2012 CPRA standings as of August 13, 2012.
 2. Contestants will enter through the CRES office on Tuesday, August 14, 8:00 am – 2:00 pm MDT. All qualified contestants must enter at this time. Any contestant who wants to be placed on the alternate list must enter at this time as well. Position callback will be available on Wednesday, August 15, 8am – 2pm MDT. Contestants will be able to trade positions until Monday, August 20 @ 2pm MDT. Contestants turning out/doctor release/vet release after Wednesday, August 15 will be replaced before the start of the first performance.
- Both members of a team must qualify through the qualifications listed in ground rule 1.
4. If a tie exists for entry into the Tour Championship, the tied contestant with the most money won in the 2012 CPRA Wrangler Rodeo Tour standings (as of August 13, 2012) will advance to the Tour Championship. If a tie still exists the tied contestant with the most money won in the Last Chance Tour standings (as of August 8, 2012 & including Jasper, Pincher Creek, Cranbrook, Lethbridge, Okotoks, Merritt, Hanna & McCord from 2011) will advance. If a tie still exists a draw will be made by the CRES staff to determine the finalist.
 5. Once stock is drawn and a contestant withdraws, the next eligible contestant will replace that contestant on the stock drawn for the original contestant.
 6. Priority for entering will be as follows:
 1. Top 10 in the 2012 Wrangler Canadian Rodeo Tour Standings
 2. Top 2 in the 2012 Last Chance Standings (including Jasper, Pincher Creek, Cranbrook, Lethbridge, Okotoks, Merritt, Hanna & McCord)
 3. Remaining Entries

FORMAT

1 head in six (6) major events & team roping, **short go & aggregate.**

Day 5 Finals

Total of eight (8) contestants will compete in the finals. If there is a turnout/doctor release/vet release in the finals the tie breaker to determine the replacement contestant will be the same as to advance to the finals. **Contestant with the most point in the aggregate will be declared the champion. If tied after two (2) head co-champions will be declared.** Tour Champions will be decided on total Tour points from the season. Points will be totaled to the end of Armstrong.

PAYOUT

Finals

\$4,000 paid out \$1600 - \$1200 - \$800 - \$400

Ground money as per CPRA Rules does not count in standings

The above payouts are per contestant in the six major events and per team in the Team Roping.

Special Competition Rules

Contestants will be allowed to compete on any animal drawn in the Sunday Finals, regardless if the contestant had drawn the animal in a previous round.
