

## **BARREL RACING GROUND RULES – LAUGHLIN, NV – 2011**

**GROUND RULES FOR LAUGHLIN, NV 3/31/2011 - 4/03/2011**

The PRCA 30 hour replacement rule will be in effect. Re-entries will be accepted for available positions on Friday March 25 between 12 and 2 PM.

**BARREL RACING --** No limits, 2 Go Rounds, back to back. Both go rounds will be random draw. The first go will be placed by PROCOM and the second go round will be drawn by rodeo secretary and judges immediately following completion of first go in slack. Barrel racing will be the first event in slack beginning at 8:00 AM each day. There will be a tractor drag following each section of 10.

The first go of each back to back group will be run as the first event in slack.

The contestants with the top 10 fastest times from the first go round will be placed in the performance. If splits result in more than 10, a flip of a coin will determine which contestant will compete in the 10<sup>th</sup> position of the performance and which contestants will compete in the slack. The number of contestants placed in the performance will not exceed 10.

The committee will have the option of designating two contestants to compete during the performance for their second go-round. The committee must notify PROCOM which 2 contestants will be placed in the performances by 5 PM, MT, the day after the first go-round trade deadline. The contestants with the top ten fastest times will be placed in the performance but an EXCEPTION could occur if the 2 contestants selected by the committee to be placed in the performances are not among the top 10 fastest times. In that case, the top 8 or 9 fastest times will be placed in the performance as well as the contestants selected by the committee to be placed in the performance until the total number of contestants in the performance reaches 10. The remainder of contestants will compete in their second go-round immediately following the slack for all other events in that group of back to back. There will be a tractor drag prior to the start of the 2nd go-round in slack.

Immediately following the completion of first go round competition in each slack, the top 10 fastest times will be determined and moved to the performance that day, along with the contestants designated by the committee if they are not among the top 10 fast times for that day.

The remaining contestants in each back to back group will run second go round in a second section of slack that same day as the last event in slack.
