Strait To The Finish Rules

Futurity & Derby General Rules

1. There are No Refunds of Entry Fees. No Exceptions.

2. No membership is required to enter Strait To The Finish
3. Completion of entry form or payment of entry fees will indicate acceptance of all rules and regulations governing this event.
4. The Futurity and Derby are open to all ages and ability of contestants, men or women may ride. There are no limits to the number of horses an owner or rider may enter.
5. Futurity and Derby Entry Forms must be accompanied by a copy of both sides of the horse's registration papers or a full description of the horse with a veterinary conformation of the horse's age.
6. Horse/Rider substitutions will be allowed with a \$40.00 substitution fee. All changes for the Futurity and Derby must be made by Friday at 12pm.
7. A long sleeve shirt (does not need to be collared), a cowboy hat or helmet, long pants, and western boots are required to be worn while a contestant is competing. A \$25 fine per rider will be assessed for not adhering to the dress code. All contestants must wear required dress code to be eligible for the average awards.
8. Contestants will be assigned stalls, pens and parking. Any horse or tack that is found in a stall or pen that has not been assigned will be fined \$100 per stall. Fine shall be paid for by the contestant or its representative prior to any further participation in the event.
9. All vehicles will park in the area designated by the Committee.
10. Use of camping electrical outlets on grounds must be requested and paid for in advance. Fines for units found plugged in without passes result in \$50.00 fines per day in addition to regular fees.
11. Damage willfully caused to any property, i.e. stalls, barns, etc., of the Committee, its lessee or subcontractors, shall be paid for by the contestant or its representative prior to any further participation in the event.
12. ALL dogs must be confined to contestant's trailer/camper area or on a leash at all times.
13. Stall/Pen reservations will be accepted after March 1. Stall reservations will be granted in the order that payment is received. Once indoor stalls are full, remaining horses will be offered outdoor pens. All horses for which no pen is reserved will receive a tie-out fee.
14. The Committee will not tolerate abuse of any animal or person by any person while at Strait To The Finish.

Payoff, Entry Fees, Deadlines & Eligibility Requirements For The Futurity and Derby:

1. An Entry fee will be deemed by the committee for the both the Futurity and Derby events, and will be posted on the official entry form. 75% of the Entry fees plus 100% added money will be paid back to contestants as the purse; 25% of the entry fees are retained by the committee for production of the event. The Futurity & Derby payout shall consist of 2 Long Go Rounds, a Short Go Round, and an Average. The Short Go qualifiers will be determined by the top 3 in each division (1D and 2D full second split) during each long go round. In the event of a tie, both competitors will compete in the short go round. The Average will be determined by a combination of the 2 long go round times and the short go round time. For each barrel that is tipped, a 5 sec penalty will be added to the time.
2. Entry Fee will consist of one payment postmarked by June 1. Failing to meet the June 1st deadline will result in a \$50.00 late fee. Only horses that have payment and paperwork postmarked by June 9th will go in the draw. Late entries received after June 9th will run at the end of the class on Friday and the beginning of the class on Saturday, and will not be accepted until all fees, including late fees, are paid.
3. The Futurity is open to horses 5 years of age and younger of the competing year. To be eligible for the Futurity, the horse must NEVER have competed in ANY barrel race, including AQHA shows, play days, novice horse events, derbies, rodeos, etc. prior to December 1 of the previous year. To do so means forfeit of any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity. The Futurity payout will be a 2D (two division event) with one second split determining the divisions.
4. The Derby is Open to horses 7 years of age and younger of the competing year. There are no rules on prior competition for the Derby. No horse may enter both the Strait To The Finish Futurity & Derby within the same year. The Derby will be a 2D (two division event) with ½ second split determining the divisions.
5. There will be a \$40 charge for every NSF check.
6. Futurity and Derby will be NRF, WPRA & UBRA approved.



Payout will be as follows for both Futurity & Derby Events:

1. 75% of Entry Fees + All Added Money will determine the Event Purse:
 - a. Long Go 1 = 25% of Purse (60% to 1D, 40% to 2D)
 - b. Long Go 2 = 25% of Purse (60% to 1D, 40% to 2D)
 - c. Short Go = 25% of Purse (60% to 1D, 40% to 2D)
 - d. Average of all 3 go's = 25% of Purse (60% to 1D, 40% to 2D)
2. Futurity Entry Fee \$200 + \$20 office fee. Derby Entry Fee \$150 + \$20 office fee
3. In the event there are not enough individuals placed for payout monies allocated, the money will be divided between those placing in the division.
4. If the event has 30 competitors or less, the top 3 in each division for each long go round will be invited back to the short go. (12 short go qualifiers)
5. If the event has 31-49 competitors, the top 4 in each division in the long go rounds will be invited back to the short go. (16 short go qualifiers)
6. If the event has 50 or more competitors, the top 5 in each division in the long go rounds will be invited back to the short go. (20 short go qualifiers)
7. Payout for the Futurity and Derby will be made each day of the event.
8. Awards will be given out to the top 3 in each division based on the combination of both long-go runs and the short go run. All winners must be present to receive their award or it will go to the next placing.

Futurity and Derby Race Rules:

1. A horse/rider combination cannot change their draw position. Horses will compete in order of draw on Friday and the order will reverse on Saturday. A new draw will be posted for the short go.
2. A maximum of three gate calls will be given, after which the horse and rider combination will be disqualified for that go-round.
3. If a contestant competes out of turn, he/she will be fined \$50.00.
4. 45 gallon metal barrels, containing both ends, will be used.
5. Not following the clover-leaf pattern will result in a no time. A broken pattern shall be defined as breaking the forward motion to retrace the tracks to finish the pattern or making more than the three turns of the cloverleaf pattern or crossing the finish line prior to completion of the run. If a contestant runs by a barrel and has to back up or turn around and retrace their tracks, this would be considered a broken pattern.
6. Prior to the performances, the barrels shall not be set on the stakes or markers, unless done so by the committee.
7. An electric timer will be used for all runs, and the race will be timed to the 1000th of a second. Should the timer malfunction a rerun will be given at the end of the race. In the event a rerun is granted, any penalties incurred during the original run will be added to the rerun.
8. There will be NO reruns given if a horse falls, is pulled up by the ride or due to malfunction of contestant's equipment.
9. If a horse qualifies for the short-go and is unable to run in the short-go, the next qualifying time will be taken.
10. Any questions or dispute which may arise during the course of the Event not covered by the above rules will be decided and settled by the committee whose decision will be final.
11. Futurity and Derby contestants may choose to carry over their time to the open.

Payoff, Entry Fees, Deadlines & Eligibility Requirements For The Open 4D and Youth 4D Barrel Race:

1. All fees are due at check in/registration and must be paid prior to making your run.
2. No Refunds will be given— entries may be sold with a \$5 office fee per change.
3. A long sleeve shirt (does not need to be collared), a cowboy hat or helmet, long pants, and western boots are required to be worn while a contestant is competing. A \$25 fine per rider will be assessed for not adhering to the dress code. All contestants must wear required dress code to be eligible for the average awards (Futurity, Derby, Youth, Open and Peewee).
4. Rerun will be given to horses if the timer fails. We will drag after every 5 riders, with the big drags every 50 riders.
5. The three call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified.
6. Contestants must run in the draw order – no switching draw positions!



7. Late Entries for the Peewee, Youth and Open will be accepted on site until the final horse runs in each class. A late entry draw will be made after horse 100 in the Open runs. Any entries after horse 100 will be added on to the end in the order of entry. Late entry fee is \$30.00 for the weekend per rider.
8. 75% Entry fees payback & 100% added money. Each race is separate payoff.
9. Awards will be given on the average of all three runs (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) in the Peewee, Youth and Open Divisions.
10. Open classes will be a 4D format with a half second split between divisions. UBRA, BBR & WPRA Approved. Pre-entry draw will be posted on-line Tuesday prior to the event. Youth Class will be 4D with a half second split between divisions. (Youth 18 & under as of Jan 1, Peewee 10 & under as of Jan 1).
11. Youth class will have the option to carry their time from the youth to the open but must let the office know before your run!
12. Any excessive whipping, jerking or tuning in the competition arena will NOT be tolerated. A warning will be issued to leave the arena. If not followed, a \$50.00 fine will be assessed.
13. Riders MUST maintain forward motion or result in disqualification.
14. A horse may only enter each race once.
15. You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run.
16. Contestants will receive a no time for knocking over a barrel or breaking the pattern.
17. A tie for award will be handled by a flip of a coin between contestants tied.
18. We reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason. Strait Rail Ranch will have the final say on all rulings.
19. All winners must be present to receive your awards. If you are not going to be available to receive your award you may have someone else pick it up. If no one shows up during award presentation to receive your award it will go to the next person. All awards will be given out at the conclusion of the Open on Sunday.

Pole Bending Rules

1. 3D format full second splits.
2. Tipped pole will result in a No Time.
3. Entries accepted onsite until the 1st horse runs in the class.
4. 75% entry fee paid back.
