UBRA 2014 Rocky Mountain Power Futurity Rules

April 19 & 20, 2014, Heber UT

1. The Futurity will be 2D with full second split.
2. All runners will enter the arena thru the alley way and exit out the alley way. No exceptions. Any runner entering from anywhere other than the alley way will be disqualified. One circle is allowed. If you are in the warm-up arena, please be cautious and courteous of horses running in and out of the alley way. The next 15 runners will be the only horses allowed in the warm-up arena.
3. Futurity nomination & fee schedule: \$100 nomination postmarked by February 1, 2014. One payment of \$100 needs to be postmarked by March 1, 2014, and \$75 postmarked by April 1, 2014. Total entry fee is \$275. No Exceptions on postmark and late fees.
4. The Futurity is open to all riders. A rider may ride more than one horse. Owners do not have to ride horses.
5. Dress Code: long sleeve shirt, long pants, boots and western hat or helmet is required in Futurity and all other races.
6. Futurity is open to foals of 2009 & 2010 (4 & 5 year olds); copy of both sides of registration papers must accompany nomination payment. Unregistered horses must show proof of age with a vet's affidavit and must accompany nomination payment.
7. To be eligible for the Futurity horse must never have competed in a barrel race prior to December 1, 2013.
8. To be eligible for the Amateur 2D side-pot rider cannot have won more than \$2,000 lifetime in barrel racing futurities prior to Dec 1, 2013, and never before held a WPRA Card.
9. Horse or Rider futurity substitution will be allowed for death, illness or unsoundness with a \$50 change fee and Vet / Dr. release. Notify Kristi Brangle 801-440-0827. Email release to krbrangle@hotmail.com Deadline for substitution & Vet / Dr. release is Monday **April 14, 2014, 4:00 pm**. \$50 change fee must be paid by Friday April 18th.
10. 70% of entry fee & 100% of added money will be jackpotted. All nomination fees and payments will be included in payout. Two go's and an average will be paid in the Futurity: 60% to 1D, 40% to 2D. (1st go 30%, 2nd go 30%, Average 40%).
11. Average prizes and money will be awarded in the futurity. A true average system using the combined horse & rider's times from each day will determine the futurity average champion and 2D futurity average champion. Must be present or have a designated person pick up your award.
12. Futurity horses will be numbered and markings checked against original registration papers at mandatory check-in on Friday, April 18, 2014 from Noon to 4:00 pm in the warm-up arena, please bring original registration papers to Check-In.
13. Late nominations may be made by paying a \$25 late fee plus \$10 for each missed payment or payment not postmarked by the due date. The last day to enter the Futurity is Friday April 18, 2014 by 2 p.m. Any fees paid after April 7, 2014, including late fees, must be cash or certified funds. Late fees and substitution fees will be retained by the UBRA.
14. Futurity buy-outs will be allowed with payment of the \$25 late fee and will be handled by The UBRA. Absolutely no refunds of futurity nomination or entry fees – no exceptions.
15. The futurity will start at 10:00 am Saturday and Sunday. The Futurity draw will be reversed on Sunday. Late futurity entries will run after pre-entries both days.
16. Horses running in Futurity **may carry over** time into the Open 5D, and WPRA open side-pot. Future Champions (Saturday) will run at 11:00 am (not before). Youth 3D, followed by Open 5D will start at 12:00 Noon (not before).
18. Stall Reservations are handled by Wasatch County and done online. To reserve stalls see www.utbra.com Futurity page and follow the link to Wasatch County's stall reservation system. No tying at trailers over-night and no outside shavings are allowed. Dogs are not allowed inside the barn, but can be tied to trailers.
19. Ground will be raked every 5 runners with a tractor and big drags will be determined. Horses will not be worked on markers, barrels are not allowed in the arena during open ride or any other time April 18, 19, 20, 2014, except during time only.
20. The futurity is WPRA co-sanctioned. Horse (if eligible) must be nominated with WPRA for WPRA points. Please see the WPRA's website futurity page for rules www.wpra.com

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2014 Rules, Clarifications & Waiver

This form must be signed and accompany entry form

- **NO DOGS** allowed in the indoor arena.
- **Horse must be named on entry form.** Please enter with horse's registered name.
- **Horse and rider must run in order drawn** or be disqualified. There is no charge for a horse change in the Youth and/or 5D for horses that are not already included in the draw. Please see the office before 11:30 am.
- **Friday night race** will be 4D (1/2 sec split) or 5D (1/2 sec split) if over 200 entries.
- **Youth 3D** will be a full second split for any rider 15 and under day of the race. Youth can carry over into the Open 5D and will run at 12:00 noon Sat. and Sun. Youth 3D Average awards will be based on the fastest time from each day.
- **Open 5D** will be 1/2 second split and will run after the Youth 3D. 5D Average awards will be based on the fastest time from each day.
- **\$1000 Cash Target Race** side-pot horse and rider with the two closest times Sat & Sun will win \$1000 cash! Target prizes will also be awarded.
- **Future Champions:** Helmets are required for this race. We will have helmets if you need one. 6 and under day of race on a smaller pattern. This is for our future barrel racers not running in the open or youth that still need a little encouragement. Limited to one entry per rider. Future Champion race starts at 11:00 am Saturday. **Everyone gets money a prize!!**
- **Dress code** required for Future Champs, Youth, Open and Futurity – long sleeve shirt (collar not req.), long pants, western boots, western hat or helmet.
- **Youth and 5D Pre-entries** must be postmarked by 4/7/14 to avoid a \$10 late fee. Late entries for Youth and Open 5D will be taken the day of the race until the last runner and will be charged a \$10 late fee. Late entries taken on Saturday for both days will run at the end on Saturday and Sunday.
 - Pre-entered day runners will be included in the draw. There will be separate draws done for the Youth and Open 5D Saturday and Sunday. Late entries will run at the end both Saturday and Sunday. Late draw will be completed during the big drag before the last 50 pre-entries.
- **Running Order:** Saturday running order will be: Futurity, Future Champions, Youth 3D, Open 5D. Sunday running order will be: Futurity (reverse), Futurity Award Presentation, Youth 3D, Open 5D (new draw), Youth and 5D Average Awards Presentation. Must be present or have a designated person pick up your award at the race.
- **All runners will enter the arena thru the alley way** and exit out the alley way. No exceptions. One circle is allowed. Any runner entering from anywhere other than the alley way will be disqualified. If you are in the warm-up arena, please be cautious and courteous of horses running in and out of the alley way. The next 15 runners will be the only horses allowed in the warm-up arena.
- **Horses will not be worked on markers** and barrels are not allowed in the arena during open ride or any other time April 18, 19, 20, 2014, except during UBRA time only.
- **Stall and RV** Reservations are handled by Wasatch County: visit www.utbra.com Futurity page, follow the link to Wasatch County's stall reservation system. Stalls will be reserved upon full payment. If you are going to be late make sure you have made arrangements with the county ahead of time. No outside shavings allowed and please do not tie horses to trailers overnight. Dogs are not allowed inside the arena.
- **WPRA:** Rider must be WPRA member to enter WPRA Side-pots and can enter one time.
- **2D Derby** is 1/2 sec. split, open to all 2nd and 3rd year horses 5, 6 & 7 years old. WPRA co sanctioned.
- **Dr/Vet Outs** 70% of 5D entry fee will be refunded with Dr/Vet release. Must notify office before race starts.
- **UBRA Member Incentive** Must be a 2014 member of UBRA to enter the UBRA Member incentive race.
