DR HORTON CLASSIC 2012 GROUND RULES

1. You do NOT need to be a member of any association to enter ANY of our classes.
2. Mandatory Liability Waiver must be signed and submitted prior to competition. Failure to do so will result in NT -all three days.
3. \$5,000 Added in Open 5D. \$5,000 Added in BBR Western Region Tour Challenge Finals. \$500 Added in Open Average Side Pot. \$100 Added in Novice Horse 4D Average Side Pot. \$250 Added in WPRA Permit Only Side Pot.
4. **Postmark date is SEPTEMBER 5th 2012.**
5. **No email entries; except for those who are set up or authorize us to electronically debit your account for your fees.** Otherwise its mail in entries only and full payment must be made at time of entry. \$30 service charge on any NSF checks/electronic debit. Checks AND electronic transactions will be deposited the week of September 9th.
6. **NEW THIS YEAR: NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON-SITE. THIS IS A PRE-ENTER ONLY EVENT. WE ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT BBR WESTERN REGION TOUR CHALLENGE FINALE ENTRIES TO BBR A WEEK PRIOR TO THE EVENT. ALL BBR SIDEPOT ENTRIES ARE SUBJECT TO FINAL APPROVAL BY BBR.**
7. **Final draws will be posted no later than September 17th.**
 - Friday and Saturday the draws will be random (no reverse order like years past). Special needs, let us know with your entries and we will work with you.
 - Sunday Draw: Those who have two clean runs will come back first. We will run you slowest to fastest on your two run combined time. This will allow us to get average calculations completed in a timely fashion.
8. **ONE TIME PROCESSING FEE.** You only pay it once, regardless of how many horses, classes, or days you are entering.
9. **Check In:** Fairgrounds is not available for our event until 9 am Friday 9/21/2012. Please plan your arrival accordingly. Arena will be open for Riding Sessions and Exhibitions only. No open riding available in the competition arena at any time during the weekend. Outdoor warm up arena will be available for exercising/riding horses. No turnouts. You must keep horses in control at all times. County Rules.
10. Ride Sessions and exhibitions will be offered Friday afternoon prior to the start of the event at 4 pm. Please refer to flyer for details on how to reserve them.
11. Open and BBR Western Region Tour Challenge Finale is BBR approved with 75% payback. All other classes Mile Hi Standard Payout. WPRA Permit Only Side Pot = WPRA Payout.
12. Open 5D will be on ½ second splits. Knocked over barrel, broken pattern, tack failures, running out of turn, swapping draw positions, will result in a no-time.
13. Roll-Times. You may roll your time from any class to any class (no restrictions – except the Slot Race – you may NOT roll to/from the Slot Race). You MUST enter both classes and pay all fees and indicate that you are rolling on your entry form. Failure to do so will require you make both runs. With an event this size, WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE ROLLS. However, YOU do what is best for you! We will make it happen for you.
14. We ask that you PLEASE use your HORSE'S REGISTERED NAME. If your horse is not registered, just enter the name you call him—this information is needed for average calculations.
15. You may enter multiple horses in any class. NO switching of draw positions and NO substitution of riders.
16. No circling allowed in ANY class.
17. Every horse must be stalled. **No PORTABLE PENS OR TYING TO TRAILER OVERNIGHT. ONE HORSE PER STALL.** Facility policy. We have negotiated a special weekend rate that saves a few dollars!
18. We will be awarding beautiful Average Champion saddles to the 3-day Average Champions in the Open 1D, 2D, 3D, 4D and 5D. Average saddles will be awarded as soon as possible on Sunday (after all of those who have 2 clean runs complete the competition). The saddles will be presented in the main competition arena and you will be expected to be in full dress code for photo shoot!
 - To be eligible to win Average prizes, you must be a member in good standing of Mile Hi and have competed in 8 of our barrel races—these 3 days count.
 - The 1D average will be based on the contestant with the fastest combined times on three runs; same horse/rider combination. It is YOUR responsibility to ensure entry accuracy. If you find an error, you MUST notify the office immediately and prior to your run. We will be presenting the awards based on our Office Draw Sheets.
19. All classes will receive Average Awards (items and number of placing TBD based on participation). Awards must be claimed at the race; we will make every effort to have calculations completed in a timely fashion.
20. No Refunds. This is ONE OF ONLY TWO no refund events we produce. Therefore, there will be no refunds for any reason. Vet releases must be received in riding by 5 pm September 14th. Office charges will be retained for any Vet/Med release.
21. Full western dress code required for all classes. Long sleeve shirt, hat, boots (heels down, helmets, acceptable).
22. Mile Hi reserves the right to deny any entry.
23. **PLEASE NOTE: No Alcoholic Beverages permitted unless purchased on-site via concessions. Doing otherwise will result in NT/DQ for entire weekend.** All dogs must be on a leash.
24. Mile Hi will not tolerate any harassing or threatening of show officials (including but not limited to producer, sponsors, ground crew, office crew, barn manager, facility manager, etc) by a contestant, their family members, or their traveling partners. Unsportsmanlike conduct, dishonesty, harassment or threatening behavior and/or animal abuse WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. Participating in such will result in disqualification and removal from the facility.
25. \$100 Fine will be assessed to anyone found treating a horse in an abusive or inhumane manner while on the premises of Larimer County Fairgrounds; whether in the arena, warm up pen, parking lot, tied to your trailers, in the stall barn, etc.
