

Tour of Champions Rules and Regulations

Dress Code & Fines

Dress Code will be enforced. Contestants must wear long sleeve shirt or collared shirt, long pants, a cowboy hat, and boots. There is a \$10 hat fine for losing your hat during a run.

Circling Barrels

There is a \$10 fine for circling a barrel more than once during a competition run.

Alleyway Rules

Only one horse can be in the arena. A contestant can have someone over the age of 18 help them in on foot or horseback, but they must be out of the alleyway before the contestant turns the 2nd barrel or the rider will receive a \$10 fine.

Rider/Horse Substitution

You can substitute a rider or change horses but it must be submitted to the office, in writing at least 1 hour prior to show start time. There will be a "change form" available at the office.

Pre-Entry Draw

We will do our best to accommodate all NECESSARY requests. There will be no changing or switching draw positions after draw is done.

Late Draw

Late entries will be accepted and will be CASH ONLY onsite and will be taken until the first horse runs Saturday morning. There will be a \$20 late fee per person (not per entry)/per day. Late draw will be posted 1 hour after start of the show.

Returned Checks

There is a \$30 service charge on all returned checks. If the check is not made good within 30 days of the event the contestant will not be able to attend any other Tour of Champion events and Infinity Productions will be forced to take legal action.

Horses Must Be Stalled

All horses on the grounds must have a stall if staying overnight. There will be NO TIEOUTS. There will be a \$25 fine for any horse tied out and contestant will be disqualified.

RV Sites

RV/Living Quarter Parking will be available on a first come first serve basis. The cost will be \$30 per night. Amount of spaces will determine where show is being held.

Dogs

All dogs must be on a leash at all times. There is a \$25 fine will be accessed for anyone who breaks this rule.

Vendors

There will be no selling of any type of merchandise or professional services anywhere on the grounds without prior arrangements being made with the Tour of Champions

No Times

A No time will be given for any of the following reasons:

- a. If a contestant misses the barrel pattern or stops forward motion
- b. If a contestant runs out of turn
- c. If a contestant hits a barrel. Touching a barrel to keep it up is allowed
- d. If the contestants horse falls during a run and breaks the pattern, or if the rider falls off the horse after the horse is in forward motion
- e. If the contestant is not able to get their horse in the arena within a 2 minute time limit. This rule will be enforced at the discretion of the announcer.
- f. If the contestant circles their horse in the arena, after they break the timers.

Re-Runs

Re-Runs will be granted if the official timer and back up timer fails, unless a barrel has been knocked over resulting in a no time or if the barrels are not placed on the correct markers.

Ties

If any contestant's times are tied, the prize money will be added together and split equally. Any ties for awards will result in coin toss.

Negative Coggins

Negative coggins are required and will be check at every show.

Photos & Videos

All horses may be photographed and videoed.

Sportsmanship

All persons on the grounds are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times! No inhumane behavior towards any animal at a Tour of Champions event will be tolerated. You will be asked to leave the event immediately. Foul language, misconduct or abusive comments spoken to any contestant, spectator, staff members, or arena personal will result in an immediate disqualification and you will be asked to leave the show.

Rule Changes

Tour of Champions reserves the right to add or modify any existing rules.

Classes

Senior will be open to anyone the age of 45 and up (as of Jan 1st). The seniors is a side pot class and will use carry over time from the Saturday open and will be paid out in a 4D format.

Youth will be open to anyone the age of 18 & under (as of Jan 1st). The Youth can be run after Saturdays open or can carry over Saturday open time. Youth will be paid out in a 4D format.

Futurity will be a side pot class and it will use carry over time from Saturday open. Futurity is open to all horses' ages 5 year and younger, and may never have competed for money, prizes, or points any time prior to Dec 1st of the previous year. The futurity will be paid in a 3D format with full second splits.

Open This class is open to any horse or any rider of any age or breed. An Open horse can only be run one time in the open class. The horse CANNOT be rode by different riders in the same class. Horse can run in Open and Youth

Payouts

Poles will be paid in a 3D NBHA format and will pay 75%/25% of entry fees and 100% of added money

Youth will be paid in a 4D NBHA format and will pay 75%/25% of entry fees and 100% of added money

Seniors will be paid in a 4D NBHA format and will pay 75%/25% of entry fees and 100% of added money

Futurity will be paid in a 3D NBHA format and will pay 75%/25% of entry fees and 100% of added money
