No slack. No entry fees.

Qualifications: Limited to 50. Qualifications will be as follows: 5 will be selected from 2012 pro rodeo Standings based on winning seven days prior to entry closing; 45 will be selected from 2011 pro rodeo Standings. If a contestant qualifies in both categories (2011 & 2012 money won) she will assume the position among the 2012 qualifiers.

Format: Three go-rounds back to back. (5 brackets of 10 contestants each will account for the first 15 performances). The top 4 money winners (twenty total) in each bracket will advance to the semi-finals. Each semi-final round will consist of two performances (Semi-final 1: performances 16 & 17: Semi-final 2: performances 18 & 19). No previous times will be carried forward. If there is a tie, the tie will be broken by any go-round winner in the bracket, if still tied: it will be broken by any single fastest time. If still tied, the tie will be broken based on the 2011 money won.

There will be an extended grace period for those contestants who are entered and meet qualifications to change preferences Jan 11, 3-5pm.

No multi-event buddy groups will be accepted.

The 30 hour replacement rule will be in effect.

The qualifiers for the two semifinals performances will be seeded as follows:

Semi-final 1 (perf 16&17) includes:

Semi-final 2 (18&19) includes:

- #3 Money Winner from Bracket 2
- #2 Money Winner from Bracket 3

#4 Money Winner from Bracket 3
#1 Money Winner from Bracket 4
#3 Money Winner from Bracket 4
#2 Money Winner from Bracket 5
#4 Money Winner from Bracket 5

The actual competition order will be drawn randomly. Contestants will have 30 minutes after the end of the 3rd go-round of their event to trade positions with another contestant from their bracket. The top 5 from each semi-finals (based on total money won from their perspective go-round and semi-final) will advance to the finals (20th performance).

If there is a tie, the tie will be broken by single fastest time in the semi-finals, if still tied: it will be broken by most money won prior to the semi-finals in the brackets. If still tied, the tie will be broken by any go-round winner in the bracket. If still tied, the tie will be broken based on 2011 money won. No previous time will be carried forward.

The Finals (20th performance) will consist of 10 contestants (5 from each of the semi-finals). The event champion will be determined by most money won at the 2012 San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. If there is a tie, the tie will be broken by single fastest time in the finals, if still tied; it will be broken by most money won prior to the finals (bracket plus semi-finals). If still tied, the tie will be broken by any go-round winner in the bracket. If still tied, the tie will be broken by official 2011 money won. Payoff for S.A.L.E. will be done through the WPRA office.

Payoff:

Payoff for the first 19 performances (including semi-finals). No average. Each performance pays \$4,912.50

Payoff for the finals \$31,112.50

Money will be divided equally in case of splits and any odd pennies will be dropped.

Any contestant who turns out of S.A.L.E without a valid release, visible will not be eligible to enter S.A.L.E in 2013.

Any money won shall not count for Texas Circuit Standings or as a Texas Circuit rodeo count.

All contestants must sign a release of liability with the secretary before competing in this rodeo. No dogs will be allowed on the grounds, with the exception of contract acts. All contestants will check in at Coliseum/AT & T Center West Gate/ Gate A on Houston Street upon arrival. Contestants must park horse trailers in the designated ProRodeo parking area.

All contestants with horses- must have proof of current Coggins Test (valid within twelve months of date of admission), health papers and meet Texas Animal Health Regulations. No exceptions. Contestants must abide by San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo regulations for entry and exit with animals. Individuals who violate animal entry policies will be subject to immediate ejection from the premises.

All contestants must compete in all go-rounds in order to advance into the semi-finals and/or finals.

Due to the limited number of stalls available, arrival time at the Coliseum/AT & T Center will be at 2:00pm one day prior to the performance they are up at and departure time is 10:00am one day after the performance they are up at. Stalls will be assigned to contestants at Coliseum/AT&T Center on a first come, first serve basis.
