June 15th-17th, 2012

Futurity Rules and Payout

The futurity will be 2 go rounds and an average. It will be a 2D format: full second split. 5 second penalty for each tipped barrel.

\$150 entry fee – 75% payback of entry fees - \$1000 added with 100% payback of added money

Payout: 1D 60% 2D 40%

1st Go – 25%

2nd Go – 25%

Average – 50%

There will be awards through 3rd place 1D and 2D.

Nominations due: May 1st - \$100

June 1st - \$125 Includes processing fee and stall fee (one bag of shavings included.) Additional bags are \$7 or bring your own. Stalls are mandatory. Nomination will not be accepted without stall and processing fee.

Any payment postmarked after May 1st will be charged a \$25 late fee. Late entries are accepted until June 1st (with a \$25 late fee.) No entries will be accepted after June 7th. The 2nd payment will be accepted until June 7th with an additional \$50 late fee.

Copy of horse's registration papers and coggins must accompany the first nomination payment. Unregistered (grade) horses are not eligible to compete in this futurity. Current health papers are required for any out of state horses. You must present original registration papers when checking in at the futurity. Check in will be 8-9 am June 16th. Horses will not be eligible to compete unless they have been checked in.

The futurity is open to horses five years old and younger. The horse cannot have been competed on prior to 12/01/11. This included play days, WSCA shows, AQHA, rodeos, etc. If proof is found that your horse has been competed on prior to this date you will be disqualified and your money will not be refunded.

Owners may enter and ride more than one horse. The owner does not have to ride his or her own horse.

Rider substitutions are allowed up to one hour before each run. No horse substitutions are allowed except in the case of death of originally entered horse. Any horse substitutions must be made by June 7th and must be accompanied by a vet's affidavit proving the death of the horse. Any horse substitution made must pay a \$20 office charge.

Dress code: Cowboy hat and boots. The rest is at your discretion.

Absolutely no refunds for any reason. This includes but is not limited to veterinarian and medical releases, personal issues, etc.

The three call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified. You must be in the warm up pen during the drag prior to your run.

Futurity entries are not eligible to compete in the derby.

Derby Rules and Payout

The derby will be 2 go rounds and an average. It will be a 2D format: full second split. 5 second penalty for each tipped barrel.

The payout schedule will depend on the number of entries.

Payout: 1D 60% 2D 40%

1st Go – 25%

2nd Go – 25%

Average – 50%

\$150 entry fee – 75% payback of entry fees - \$1000 added with 100% payback of added money.

Nominations due: May 1st - \$100

June 1st - \$125 Includes processing fee and stall fee (one bag of shavings included.) Additional bags are \$7 or bring your own. Stalls are mandatory. Nomination will not be accepted without stall and processing fee.

Any entries postmarked after May 1st will be charged a \$25 late fee. An additional \$50 late fee will be charged to entries received after June 1st. Entries will not be accepted after June 7th

The derby is open to horses ages 7 and under. Horses competing in the futurity are not eligible to enter the derby.

All entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers and coggins papers. Unregistered (grade) horses are not eligible to compete in the derby. Current health papers are required for any out of state horses. You must present the original registration papers when checking in for the derby. Check in will 8-9 am June 16th. Horses will not be eligible to compete unless they have been checked in.

Owners may enter and ride more than one horse. The owner does not have to ride his or her own horse.

Rider substitutions are allowed up to one hour before each run. No horse substitutions are allowed except in the case of death of originally entered horse. Any horse substitutions must be made by June 7th and must be accompanied by a vet's affidavit proving the death of the horse. Also, any horse substitutions made must pay a \$20 office charge.

Dress code: Cowboy hat and boots. The rest is at your discretion.

Absolutely no refunds for any reason. This includes but is not limited to veterinarian and medical releases, personal issues, etc.

The three call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified. You must be in the warm up pen during the drag prior to your run.

The second go will be run in reverse order.

We will drag after every 5 runners.
