

Ground Rules: WPRA CA Circuit Divisional/Permit Finals
November 3, 2012 Shandon, CA Spurr Arena

We are referring to the WPRA Divisional/Permit Finals as WPRA California Divisional Circuit Finals as: WPRA CDCF 2012 on Awards

Cut-off date for money won, was changed from September 19th to September 30th 2012.

The CDCF will consist of 24 contestants: The Top 12 WPRA Permit holders (including money won at rodeos and co-sanctioned events), and the Top 12 WPRA Card holders (including money won Only at co-sanctioned events).

YOU MUST ENTER THE CDCF IN ORDER TO COMPETE. If you are not in the Top 12 Permit or Divisional Standings, you may enter anyway and if all positions are not filled, eligibility will drop down to the next highest money winner WHO HAS ENTERED the CDCF.

Entry Fees for the CDCF is \$55, and it will be a WPRA straight payout. WPRA dress code is required for the CDCF. You must pay your entry fees to Marilyn Manning by 10:30 AM on November 3rd.

This year the WPRA CDCF will be held in conjunction with the Spurr Ranch 2012 Barrel Racing Challenge Open 4-D, which has \$5,000 added, and is WPRA co-sanctioned. Please refer to the WPRA website under "Events Scheduled" for complete information for the November 3rd Spurr Ranch Open barrel race. The Open 4-D will start at 11 AM, and the CDCF will start as soon as the Open Race has run all contestants other than the CDCF Finals Contestants. Time onlys will be from 8:00 AM to 10:30 AM.

As in the past, you can choose to also enter the Open 4-D race and have the time you run at the Finals be your time for the Open race as well. (carry your time over) Entries for the Open race are taken on the day of the race. Be sure to tell the secretary when you enter the Open that you will actually make your Open run at the Finals so that they will not put you somewhere else in the draw. Also, if you are planning to run more than one horse in the Open, be sure to tell the secretary so she can try to place you in a drag that is far enough away from the Finals for you to make any changes necessary. If you have any questions about this, call Marilyn Peterson.

Marilyn Manning will be taking entries for the CDCF between 8 AM and 10 AM or between 4 PM and 6 PM on Saturday, October 20th. Call Marilyn at: 805-441-9715 You must speak with her directly; don't just leave a message. Even if you don't qualify, I encourage you to enter the Finals-almost every year there are people who are qualified who do not enter for one reason or another. The Finals slots will be filled by the next contestant based on money won, who HAS ENTERED the Finals! When you enter Marilyn will give you a confirmation number, and if you are not in the Top 12 she will give you a call-back time so you will know if you are entered.

10 Raffle Tickets are Required to be sold (or \$100) for eligibility to receive Circuit Jacket and Awards.

We will hold an Awards Ceremony for the CDCF at the finish of the CA Junior Circuit Finals which will follow the CDCF. You must be present to accept awards in full WPRA dress code for a picture! There will be Awards for every qualifier, so all 24 qualifiers should be present at the end of the CDCF and CJDF.

We will invite the CA Rookie of the Year. She will receive an Award following the finish of the Juniors Race.
