



2014 CC5D Ground Rules

Race Formats, Office Fees, Late Fees: Entry Fee: \$55 per run. Office Fee: \$20 one time per weekend per rider. Late fee (if applicable) \$15 one time per weekend per rider. WPRA approved.

DRESS CODE & FINES Dress code will be enforced. Contestants must wear long pants, a long sleeve shirt, a cowboy hat or equestrian helmet and cowboy boots or equestrian sport shoes. A \$10 fine will be enforced if the contestant loses a hat in the arena.

CIRCLING BARRELS MORE THAN ONE TIME A \$10 fine will be enforced. If a barrel was circled more than one time and it affects the dirt directly around the barrel, we may drag that barrel prior to next runner.

ALLEY RULES Only one horse/rider may be in the arena at any given time. A contestant can have someone assist them into the alley (only), but must exit the alley before the contestant turns the 2nd barrel or the rider will receive a \$10 fine. The rider will be given a no time if the person assisting crosses the plane of the alley into the arena.

The \$10 fines will be accounted for and the money collected will be donated to a charity at the end of season.

OPEN 5D: \$6,450 added CASH. This CC5D season qualifier is one race ran in 3 sections. You can enter the same horse/rider combination up to 3 times (1 time in each section). If you enter the same horse/rider combination you have the opportunity to win money on all runs. Day money will be awarded for the fastest times run each day and then the Big Payout will be awarded on Sunday for the fastest combined times from Friday-Sunday. The payout will be computed so that the last hole in the 5D will win a minimum of \$110. Percentages: 28%, 24%, 20%, 16%, 12% with 1/2 second splits. Day money presented directly following the race each day & Big Payout awarded on Sunday. Any cash not claimed at the conclusion of the weekend, will be mailed to address on the entry form 2 weeks after the conclusion of the race. Any awards not claimed at the conclusion of the race, will be mailed COD to the winning person at their request or held for 30 days. After 30 days, the unclaimed awards will be forfeited.

AVERAGE 4D Incentive Races: \$400 added CASH. One payout after the race on Sunday. \$25 Entry Fee. This is an incentive sidepot of the Open 5D; you must enter this to be eligible for the Average Money. Your fastest two times on the same horse/rider, from the open 5D, will carry over to the incentive & determine your place in the 4D incentive race. If you enter the Open 5D Race all 3 days with the same horse/rider combination, we will use your fastest two times to determine your placing in the average. Entering the "Average Incentive" is optional. Payback: 75% of entry, 100% of added, & 1 second splits. Pay-off will be computed so that last hole in the 4D will win a minimum of their entry fee. Percentages for Incentive Races: 30%, 27%, 23%, and 20%.





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RIDER AGE: Youth, Adult & Senior 4D Incentive Races: \$600 added CASH. \$25 Entry Fee. One payout after the race on Sunday. This is a side-pot of the Open 5D. Your time from the open 5D will carry over to the incentive & determine your place in the 4D incentive race. If you enter the Open 5D Race three times on the same horse/rider combination, you have the option of entering the incentive three times, as well. Entering the "Rider Incentive" is optional. The Incentive races have a \$25 Entry fee per entry - 4D Format - 1/2 second splits. Payback: 75% of entry, 100% of added. Pay-off will be computed so that last hole in the 4D will win a minimum of their entry fee. Percentages for Incentive Races: 30%, 27%, 23%, 20%. (Riders age based on Jan 1, current year) Youth Rider- 17 years and younger (WPR approved). Adult Rider- 18 to 49 years & Senior Rider- 50 years and older.

FUTURITY & DERBY SIDEPOUT: \$35 entry fee. Added cash based on # of entries: 1-10 = \$75, 11-20 = \$150, 21-30 = \$250, 31-40 = \$325, 41-50 = \$425, 51-60 = \$525. WPR approved. One payout after the race on Sunday. Open to all, Futurity horse must be 5 years old or younger, and may never have competed for money, prizes or points anytime before Dec. 1 of previous year. Derby horse must be 7 years old or younger, and must not have competed in futurities as a 4 year old. (If competed in futurity as a 4 year old, then cutoff age for derby horse is 6 years old.) The payoff will be computed so that the last hole in the 2D will win a minimum of double entry back or \$70. 2D format, 1 second split, 60% - 1D & 40% - 2D. This is a side-pot of the Open 5D. Your time from the Open 5D will carry over to determine your place in the 2D Side Pot. If you enter the Open 5D Race three times on your futurity/derby horse, you also have the option of entering the incentive three times as well, and can win money on each run.

VET OUT / MED OUT / DRAW OUT: A refund will be granted to all contestants regardless of the reason less a \$25.00 per horse service fee. The "Draw Out Form" must be completed and returned to the show secretary no later than 4:00pm on Friday of the current weekend. AFTER THIS DATE & TIME, NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON. Refunds will be mailed no earlier than 2 weeks following the conclusion of the race.

HORSE SUBSTITUTIONS/CHANGES: You can substitute a horse in this barrel race. However, if the horse is already entered for that section, you cannot place him into another draw position in that section. Any horse substitution must be made with the show secretary, in writing, at least one hour prior to your run. For substitutions/changes, you must fill out the "Change Form" and turn the form into the show secretary along with a \$10 change fee 1 hour prior to your run.

RIDER SUBSTITUTIONS: You can substitute a rider in this barrel race. However, all rider substitutions must be made with the show secretary in writing at least one hour prior to your run. If this is a new rider that was not previously entered in the race, the rider will need to fill out a new entry form and pay the \$20 office fee as well as the \$15 late fee if the entry is past postmark deadline. For substitutions/changes, you must fill out the "Change Form" and pay a \$10 change fee. New riders no change fee just the processing fee.

SECTION CHANGE: You can change the section you are running in, if there are still holes available in another section. You must fill out a "Change Form" along with a \$10 change fee and present it to the show office prior to the start of your section. You will be given comparable ground in your new section if it's available.





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PRE-ENTRY DRAW: We will do our best to accommodate NECESSARY special requests. We will not aid anyone in receiving a select place in the draw or a preferred spot on the ground. Must include request on entry form and we will do our best.

LATE DRAW: Late entries will be drawn up until approximately 2 hours prior to the end of the race or at the time the office secretaries deem it necessary to fill holes. After this time, the entries will be given the next available position to assure that all holes are filled. If there are any holes, we will move up all runs at approximately 1 hour prior to the end of the race; the new run numbers will be announced.

RETURNED CHECKS: There is a \$30 service charge on all returned checks from the bank for any reason. If a check is not replaced with a cashier's check or money order within 30 days after the check is dated, the contestant will be put on the "ineligible" list. Lone Star Arena will pursue legal remedies to collect on all returned checks.

HORSES MUST BE STALLED: All horses spending the night must be stalled in a Lone Star Arena Stall. Horses that are not stalled in a Lone Star Arena stall will be impounded and a fee of \$25 required to release the horse. 400 stalls available.

RV's: Parking places are available for \$20 per night. 97 spaces available.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash at all times. A \$20.00 fine will be assessed for failure to follow this rule.

VENDORS: There shall be no selling of any type of merchandise or professional service on the arena grounds, in stalls, or at trailers without a vendor contract or explicit permission from Lone Star Arena.

NO TIME: A "No Time" will be given to the contestant for the following reasons: a. If the contestant "circles" their horse, in the arena, after breaking the plane of the alley. b. If the contestant misses the barrel pattern or stops forward motion. c. If the contestant runs out of turn. It is the contestant's responsibility to know their draw position. d. If a contestant knocks over a barrel. A "no time" will also be given if a barrel is knocked over and it sets up again on either end. Touching a barrel, including keeping it from falling, is permitted without penalty. e. If the contestant's horse or rider falls during the run in such a manner as to break the pattern, or if the rider falls off the horse. f. If the contestant is not able to get the horse in the arena in a 60 second time limit. This rule will be enforced at the discretion of the announcer.

RE-RUNS: A re-run will be granted if the official and backup timer both fail to work properly unless a barrel has been knocked over resulting in a "no-time." If the barrels are not placed properly on their markers, a re-run shall also be granted without any penalties being applied; however, any penalty occurring on the re-run shall result in a "no-time."

TIES: If any contestant's times are tied, the prize money will be split equally and a flip of a coin or roll of dice, between the tied contestants will determine the tie for the awards.

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED: Be prepared to show.





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PHOTOS & VIDEOS: All horses will be photographed and may be videoed. The videos & photos are the sole property of Lone Star Arena & the race photographers.

POSTPONEMENT OF EVENT: Due to natural disasters, Lone Star Arena Productions reserves the right to postpone any barrel race due to a natural or man-made disaster, or if the price of diesel rises above \$5.00 per gallon. We do not like to put these conditions on any event, but feel it is not fair if only a small percentage of barrel racers can attend. Any monies collected will be refunded. If any event is postponed, we will reschedule it for a future date.

W9 FORMS: Checks and prizes will not be awarded to winners until Lone Star Arena has a current W9 Form on file for the year. W9 Forms can be found online at www.LoneStarArena.com or can be picked up in the show office. If a contestant does not have a current W9 form on file, W9 forms should be completed and returned to Lone Star Arena with CC5D entries.

CHECKS: All checks not picked up by the last day of the event will be mailed out no earlier than one week from the last day of the event.

RULES: The management of Lone Star Arena reserves the right to add to or modify any existing rules, in order to better the sport or this barrel race.
