



## CLARK COUNTY BARREL RACERS WINTER SERIES

### INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES SHEET:

5D FORMAT IN OPEN & 4D FORMAT IN SENIOR, YOUTH, & NOVICE.  
( ½ second increments in 5D & option 1 in 4D (½ second, 1 second, & 2 seconds from fastest time.)

**Prime Approval:** BRN4D **Co-sanctioned:** NBHA WA 8 & CWP

(Note to NBHA 8 members the Dec.8 race does not count for district 8 award points. The season goes from Jan. 1 thru Nov.30 . No December races count.)

**Time:** Pee Wees start @ 10:45 am. Open start @ 11:00 am.

**\*\*DOUBLE HEADER STARTS AT 10am Open, 9:45am Pee Wees\*\***

Order of races: Pee Wee, Open, Futurity, Derby, Senior, Youth, & Novice

**Time Only:** \$4.00 each 8:30 – 10:00 am Pay cash at gate.

**Pre-entries:** Open Monday prior to race, up to 8pm Thursday prior to race with no late fee. E-mail entry to: [cckbarrelracers@yahoo.com](mailto:cckbarrelracers@yahoo.com) or call 360-903-3942. \$10.00 late fee will apply after 8pm Thursday prior to race day.

**Award Fees:** Optional, if you want to go for awards the one-time award fee is as follows: Pee Wee-\$10.00. Open \$35 per horse, Senior, Youth, & Novice are \$25 per class and horse, Futurity & Derby are \$20 per class and horse.

Award Fee must be paid before any points count. Must attend 3 out of 7 races to be eligible and will not be accepting nomination fees after Feb.8, 2014 race.

Points are kept individual on all horse and rider combinations that are nominated.

**Points are awarded as following:** Up to 10 places in each division. Placings: 1<sup>st</sup>- 25, 2<sup>nd</sup>-22, 3<sup>rd</sup>-20, 4<sup>th</sup>-17, 5<sup>th</sup>-15, 6<sup>th</sup>-12, 7<sup>th</sup>-10, 8<sup>th</sup>-7, 9<sup>th</sup>-5, & 10<sup>th</sup>- 2 points.

**Office Fee:** \$6.00 per horse or \$10 office fee for 2 or more horses.

**Pee Wee:** Is for 10 and under. Pee Wee contestant cannot cross enter into any other class. Points for awards will be counted by the rider only. Example: If Sally runs her two ponies in the pee wee class, the pony with the highest placing of that days race points will be used to count for awards. (Providing that Sally had signed up for the awards.) There will be no leading a pee wee by a rider on another horse. This is in consideration of safety issues for the pee wee rider.

**Open:** Open to everyone. Entry Fee: \$50.00 Added money will be: 1-80 entries \$500 added, 81-105 entries \$750 added, 106 + entries \$1,000 added.

**Youth:** 17 years old and younger. \$25 Entry fee (no added money ).

**Senior:** 45 years old and over. \$25 Entry fee (no added money).

**Novice:** Rider or horse under \$500 winnings as of race entry date. Therefore if either horse or rider of the horse/rider combination have not made \$500 they are eligible for novice. \$25 Entry Fee (no added).

(If you go over the \$500 but are entered in the series awards, you can stay in novice for the remainder of the series. Points are kept on horse and rider combination.)

**Futurity:** Age 5 and under. Horses that have never competed in barrel racing before Dec. 1 of 2013. \$20.00 Entry Fee (no added money)

**Derby:** Age 5, 6 & 7 year old horses. 5 yr. old horses cannot enter the futurity if entered in the derby. \$20 Entry Fee (no added money). Can only compete in derby 2 years.

**Rolling Times:** You can only roll times from the Open into the other classes. Pee Wee contestant cannot roll to any class. Exception: If the Futurity or Derby class is run before Open, can roll time from the futurity or derby into the other classes.

**Sportsmanship:** Poor Sportsmanship should not be exhibited and will not be tolerated. This includes treatment of animals.

**Conflicts:** Will be handled by management putting on the races. CCBR management have the right to refuse entry and make final decisions on all conflicts.
