Ground Rules

- There are 3 classes: Pee Wee (8 and under), Youth (18 and under), and Open.
- There will be a Pee Wee draw.
- Youth and Open contestants will be in one draw called the Open draw. Youth contestants are not required to enter the open barrel race.
- Futurity side-pot contestants will carry their Rockin' the Bakken barrel race time to the side-pot.
- If a contestant circles once entered in the arena a no time will be given. Contestants must keep a forward motion toward the first barrel.
- No doubling barrels during competition.
- No time for breaking the timer upon completion of run.
- No time will be given for tipped barrels or broken pattern.
- Dress code required (long sleeve shirt, jeans, boots, western hat); photographer on site.
- \$10 fine for losing hat, your hat will be returned once the fine is paid.
- If you win an award, please stay for pictures or have someone designated to pick up your awards. No awards will be mailed out! Support our sponsors!!
- Contestants must attempt to make the fastest run possible. Any obvious attempt to "pull up" or pace their run may result in disqualification on the run.
- Exhibitions are limited to 45 seconds per rider. Exhibitions will only be run during the designated times on the schedule page. If you have purchased an exhibition and do not use the exhibition in the time frame you will not be reimbursed.
- Tickets for exhibitions must be picked up the day of race at the secretary office and presented at the gate to enter the arena.
- 60 exhibitions and time slots available from 8 am – 11:00 pm (15 min per 10 horses) will be sold on a first come first serve basis. They can be purchased on the entry form. They will be sold according to the date the entry form is postmarked. If all are sold prior to receipt of contestant entry form your money will be refunded. Sign up for exhibitions will be done the day of the race. Sign up for time slots can be completed on the entry form. If the time slot you choose is full you will be put in a time slot available that is the closest to your requested time. These are also going to be sold as first come first serve based on the date the entry form is postmarked. A list will be posted on the website so you know when your time slot is.
- Memberships to co-sanctioned associations are not required
- Late fees are applied if entry is postmarked after May 30, 2014. Cash only to late enter. We will accept late entries until the last contestant has competed. We will run pre-entries first.

Then we will run late entry group 1; late entry group 1 will close with 20 horses left to run in pre-entries. If there are more late entries following the close of late entry group 1, we will have a late entry group 2; late entry group 2 will close with 10 horses left to run in late entry group 1. If we need to have another group we will do so and its close will be determined on the day of the race by the producers. No more entries will be taken once the last contestant of the last late entry has competed. If you have multiple horses and are in the late entry groups we will not guarantee a rake between each horse. Once the race starts a table will be set up below the announcer's box; during large drags the secretary or an assistant will be at the table to take late entries. Please do not interrupt the secretary while contestants are competing.

- Draw outs will be accepted until June 2, 2014 for a full refund. Draw outs following June 2, 2014 must be accompanied by a veterinarian release or a doctor's release for a refund of entry fees only. The office fee is non-refundable following June 2, 2014.
- In the event of a tie for prizes each contestant will flip a coin to determine the winner of the prize.
- Producer decisions are final decisions. Suggestions or complaints may be brought to the producer's attention following the barrel race to help improve the race for the following year. Suggestions or complaints presented to the producer's prior to the race will be means for disqualification with no refund of fees.
