

General Steps for Limited Entry Rodeo Qualifications

These are the WPRA's general steps to fill limited entry rodeos and the process for categories that do not fill based on standings.

- Fill all categories in the order in which they are listed with money won contestants.
- Once complete if we have open positions in the Circuit-
 - Fill those positions with current year circuit card members with \$0 money won random draw. If there are still open Circuit positions, fill with Circuit Permits random draw(where applicable).
- If there are further open positions that have not filled within the Circuit-
 - Drop back to the original qualifying category(ies) to get the remaining contestants within standings
 - Then begin random draws in this order-
 - Outside Circuit card holders with no money won random draw
 - Outside circuit permit holders random draw (If Permits are eligible).
- If positions do not fill within other categories (example WPRA Tour)-
 - Drop back to the original qualifying category(ies) to get the remaining contestants within standings
 - Then begin random draws in this order-
 - Inside Circuit card holders with no money won random draw
 - Inside Circuit permit holders random draw (where applicable).
 - Outside Circuit card holders with no money won random draw
 - Outside Circuit permit holders random draw (where applicable).

** These steps are used at most limited entry rodeos but would not apply to special rodeo qualifications (e.g. Houston, Calgary etc.). These steps are subject to qualifications and contestant entry.*
