

**Eligibility:** Cards Only

**Ground Rules:** WPRA rules for this contest apply, along with Cheyenne Frontier Days Ground Rules. Entry fee will be \$375+ Procom Fee.

**Progressive Round:** The Progressive Round will be ran during slack on Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup> at 9 am and on Monday, July 15<sup>th</sup> (limited to 48 contestants) after steer roping. Progressive Round Trade Deadline will be Thursday July 11 at 5:00pm MT.

All notified turn outs and Releases from the progressive round/slack will be taken out of the draw after the turn out deadline. Positions will move up and be posted at slack. I.E. If you are number 9 and there are 2 releases prior to you, you will be draw number 7.

**Progressive Round Ties:** If there is a tie from the progressive round moving to the second round/Quarter Finals the contestant placing highest in the 2019 Pro Rodeo World Standings as of June 18, 2019 will advance.

**Round Two/Quarter Finals:** The top 72 times will advance to the first six performances. Placement procedure for the Quarter Finals will be random draw. Trade Deadline for Round Two/Quarter Finals is Friday, July 19<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. There will also be a trade deadline for the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> groups of contestants 24 hours prior to the third performance and for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> groups, 24 hours prior to the 5<sup>th</sup> performance. These additional deadlines are implemented to assist contestants who may be placed in a conflicting position at other rodeos during Round Two/Quarter Finals. Trades will NOT be accepted by the rodeo secretary. ALL TRADES MUST BE CONFIRMED THROUGH PROCOM.

**Round Two/Quarter Finals Ties:** Ties will be broken by taking the lady with the fastest time from the progressive round.

**Semi Finals Round:** The top four from each of the first six performances will advance to the semi-finals rounds on July 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>. The semifinals performances will be filled as follows. 1<sup>st</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place from performances 1, 3, and 5 and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> places from performances 2, 4, and 6 will compete in the semifinal round on Friday July 26<sup>th</sup>. 1<sup>st</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place from performances 2, 4, and 6 and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> places from performances 1, 3, and 5 will compete in the semifinal round on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup>. The Semi Finals running positions will be a random draw. Contestants will be allowed to trade in the Semi-Finals up to 24 hours prior to the 7<sup>th</sup> performance.

**Semi Finals Ties:** Will be broken by taking the lady with fastest total time on the two previous runs.

**Final Round:** The top 6 from each semifinals round will advance to the final round. Finals positions will be a random draw. **Cheyenne will not move contestants if they make the final round at another rodeo so they need to trade to avoid such a possible conflict.**

**General Rules:**

No Replacements.

Non-notified turnouts will result in a \$100 Cheyenne Frontier Days fine in addition to WPRA fine.

Contestants making the short round at another rodeo will NOT be moved.

Contestants will enter the arena from the north end.

Gate will remain closed. No foot traffic through T-4 Gate.

Open Arena barrels will be placed on the same markers as the performances.

While competing, contestants WILL WEAR THEIR OWN BACK NUMBER SECURELY PINNED ON THEIR BACK in a manner that is visible to the officials and events staff. CFD will issue a \$50.00 fine for individuals who do not have their number securely pinned on their back and visible.

No horses are permitted in the arena on slack mornings prior to the start of slack. There will be no exercising of horses in the arena prior to rodeo, night show or slack.

PRCA and WPRA Arena Rules and CFD ground rules are in effect in the ready area at the north end of the arena.

Every contestant must pay their entry fee and sign a release at the Contestants Office prior to picking up their number and competing. CFD will issue a \$50.00 fine for individuals who do not pick up their credentials prior to competing on July 16th. Only actual contestants and one companion are allowed gate access. One vehicle parking pass will be available after the first go on Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup> & Monday, July 15<sup>th</sup> , for the 72 contestants running in the performances.

There are a limited number of stalls for contestants competing. First come first served. Horses to be stalled in the Contestant Barns only.

There will be a ride time on Thursday July 11<sup>th</sup> from 1 to 4 pm. Barrels will be on the markers and only WPRA members entered in Cheyenne will be permitted in the arena for this ride time.

The CFD park must be empty by 6 pm on Friday July 12<sup>th</sup>. Contestants will NOT be permitted to stay on the grounds Friday night. There are alternate places to stay in Cheyenne and these will be displayed in the rodeo office.
