Limited Entry Rodeo Qualifier Guidelines

Location:

- Rodeo committee is to choose the location of the barrel racing qualifier.
- The WPRA suggests holding the qualifier in the location of the rodeo.

Time:

Qualifier must be held within 10 days of the rodeo start date (slack or perfs).

Producer:

- Rodeo committee may host the qualifier or choose a producer to host on their behalf.
- Qualifier may be held in conjunction with a separate barrel race, however, all qualifiers must be run first and together.
- PRCA judges must be present at the qualifier and race ran as a WPRA rodeo approved event.
- PRCA secretary
- WPRA rule book and dress code must be followed.

Payoff and Fees:

- WPRA will retain its 6% from the event.
- Payoff will be no less than 75% payback.
- Entry Fees and added money by special Board approval

Rules:

- Qualifier will be unlimited*
- Must drag at 5
- Drags will not be condensed
- Qualifying spots will be as follows
 - \$10k-\$19,999= 10 qualifying spots or 10% of contestants accepted by the rodeo, whichever is more.
 - \$20k-\$29,999= 7 qualifying spots or 10% of contestants accepted by the rodeo, whichever is more.
 - \$30k-\$39,999= 5 qualifying spots or 10% of contestants accepted by the rodeo, whichever is more.
 - \$40k+= 3 qualifying spots or 10% of contestants accepted by the rodeo, whichever is more.
- If a contestant is originally drawn out of a LER then subsequently qualifies through a qualifier, said contestant will be removed from the replacement list.

Limited Entry Rodeo Qualifier Guidelines

Alternative Options to a Qualifier:

- Rodeo Committee may choose to use other rodeos as qualifiers.
- Qualifiers may be split into separate rodeos or may take all qualifiers from a single rodeo.
- Director must approve qualifying rodeos.
- Qualifying rodeos must rake at half
- Same number of qualifying spots will be granted as outlined above.

*Permit eligibility will be handled through ground rules at director's discretion.
