

Western Region Facts Sheet

* Below is some helpful information on the Calgary Qualifier at the Western Regional Barrels and Breakaway Event. Be sure to reference the full event ground rules in the event listing at wpra.com.

How do I enter the Calgary Qualifier?

• Entries will be taken along with the Western Regional Barrels and Breakaway entries and will be open March 1st through April 5th 11pm MT. Entries will only be accepted through saddlebook.com.

Can anyone enter the Calgary Qualifier?

- The Calgary Qualifier is only open to WPRA members. Participants must also be entered in the WPRA barrel race (Card or Permit Only) or entered in the WPRA Breakaway Roping
- WPRA Contestants pre-seeded will not be eligible to enter the Calgary Qualifier.

How many places will qualify into Calgary?

• The top 2 finishers in the barrel racing average as well as the top 2 finishers in the breakaway average will qualify into Calgary.

Can I enter the Calgary Qualifier multiple times?

Yes

Barrel Racing—You may enter up to 3 horses. If you are carrying over to the WPRA Card or Permit Only Race, you must designate which horse will carry over prior to the start of competition. Should the same individual win 1st and 2nd (due to multiple horses) they will get one qualification to Calgary and the second would drop down to the next individual

Breakaway Roping—You may enter up to 2 times. Your first calf in each round will count for WPRA Breakaway and your Calgary entry #1. If entered a second time in the Calgary Qualifier, you will run a second calf at the end of each round. Should the same individual win 1st and 2nd (due to multiple entries) they will get one qualification to Calgary and the second would drop down to the next individual.

Since permits are allowed to enter the Calgary qualifier, do I have to buy my card before entering Calgary?

• Yes. If a permit holder qualifies for Calgary, they must purchase their card by the membership dues date for Calgary.

When will full qualifications for the Calgary Stampede be released?

• The WPRA Board and Calgary Stampede are working diligently to finalize the application and ground rules. Once approved, they will be released.

What will entry fees be for the WPRA events and Calgary Qualifier?

- WPRA Card Race entry fee: \$150
- WPRA Permit Only Race entry fee: \$95
- WPRA Breakaway entry fee: \$250
- Calgary Stampede Qualifier Barrel Race entry fee: \$425
- Calgary Stampede Qualifier Breakaway Roping entry fee: \$250

Is this the only Calgary Stampede qualifier?

• No—Calgary Stampede will be hosting their Ladies Barrel Racing qualifier June 11- 12 at the Nutrien Western Event Centre. The Calgary Stampede Ladies Breakaway Roping Qualifier will take place June 4-5 at the Nutrien Western Event Centre.
